Thank you for downloading this tool. **VST Plugin Preset Converter** is a tool to convert the parameters exposed by the VST plugin for automation to a human readable format (Excel, CSV, TXT, HTML).

In order to get the most out of the **VST Plugin Preset Converter**, please spend a few moments reading this brief manual.

License

The pre-compiled **VST Plugin Preset Converter** has a very simple license:

1. **VST Plugin Preset Converter** is donationware. This means that you are free to use and distribute it, give it to friends, or otherwise share it around. However, only the entire unaltered archive, including this document, may be re-distributed. If you want the development to be continued, please also consider a fair donation.
2. Copyright of the code and the finished plug-in remain the property of the *Delphi ASIO & VST Project* and namely *Christian-W. Budde*.
3. This plug-in is provided at no cost; therefore the author *Christian-W. Budde* assume no responsibility for any negative effects that may occur to the end user or the equipment used to run the plug-in.
4. Magazine editors are welcome to include the plug-in on cover mount discs or similar media; however, I request that am informed about it via [e-mail](#). A few copies of the publication are always appreciated, but not expected.

User Interface

This tool doesn't have any explicit user interface. Instead it does only show a sequence of typical open/save dialogs to select the desired files.

Alternatively you may use the command line. Here you can not only specify the VST DLL filename and the output filename, but also additionally any preset or bank file with the extension (.fxp and .fxb).

Please use it as follow

```
Preset2Excel.exe VSTPlugin.DLL Output.XLS Preset.FXP
```

All parameters of all programs are scanned and converted as good as possible. Depending on the ratio parameters/programs the one with the longest number of items is displayed in columns, while the other is displayed in rows.
