

Christortion - Manual

Welcome

Thank you for downloading this fine plug-in called ‘Christortion’.

The plug-in simply excites the harmonics of the input signal. It is also possible to invert the phase of each harmonic. This concept guarantees a very surgical control over the distortion produced.


In order to get the most out of ‘Christortion’, please spend a few moments reading this brief manual.

‘Christortion’ has a very simple license:

Controls




Each of the eight sliders above adjust one harmonic (except the first being the fundamental frequency). The checkboxes below act as 'Phase Invert' switch. If checked, the phase of the signal is inverted.

The chart on the bottom of the GUI gives a preview of how a simple sinewave is affected if running through the plugin.

The mountain on the right is the 'Corcovado' with 'Cristo Redentor' on top of it. The mountain is located in the heart of 'Rio de Janeiro' as part of the tijuca forrest, a huge national park inside the city.

Here you can find a plot of the THD produced by this plugin. It's exactly what it should do:
